**John ALLEN, farmer of Lyddington**

**Will dated 1811**

### RMUS

1 This is the last Will and Testament of  
2 me John Allen of Lyddington in the County of Rutland  
3 Farmer I give and devise unto my eldest Son Henry Allen  
4 All that my \Copyhold/ Messuage Cottage or Tenement with the Yard  
5 Barnes Stables Outbuildings and Appurtenances to the same  
6 belonging situate standing and being in Lyddington aforesaid  
7 and now in my own occupation And also all that Copyhold  
8 Homestead orchard or small Close or inclosed piece or parcel of  
9 Land adjoining or near adjoining to my Said Messuage Cottage  
10 or Tenement and now also in my own occupation (having first  
11 Duly surrendered the same to the use of my Will) To Hold the  
12 same unto my said Son Henry Allen his Heirs and Assigns  
13 for ever according to the Custom of the Manor of Lyddington with  
14 Caldecott in the said County of Rutland of which the same are  
15 holden Also I give and devise unto my youngest John Allen  
16 All that my Copyhold Close plot piece or parcel of Land or  
17 Ground situate lying and being at Lyddington aforesaid within  
18 and held of the same Manor of Lyddington with Caldecott  
19 aforesaid now also in my own occupation and containing by  
20 estimation Eleven Acres Three Roods and Thirty four perches or  
21 thereabouts (little more or less) (the same being also surrendered  
22 to the use of my said Will) To hold to him my said Son John  
23 Allen his Heirs and Assigns for ever according to the custom of  
24 the said Manor Also I give bequeath and devise unto my said  
25 Son Henry Allen All and singular my Household Goods Furniture  
26 and other Effects of a like sort or kind And also all my ready Money  
27 and Securities for Money Farming Stock, Cattle and Implements  
28 in husbandry And all other my real and personal Estate and  
29 Effects whatsoever and wheresoever and of what nature kind or  
30 Quality the same be or consist at the time of my Decease not
