Will proved 1763

1 This is the Last Will  
2 and Testament of Edward Allin of Liddington in the  
3 County of Rutland Tanner I give and Devise unto my beloved  
4 Wife Martha Allin my Friend James Dell of Liddington aforesaid  
5 Yeoman and their heirs all and singular my Messuages Cottages  
6 Closes Lands Tenements and Heriditaments whatsoever with the  
7 Appurtenances in Morcott in the said County of Rutland and elsewhere  
8 within the Kingdom of Great Britain in trust that they or the  
9 Survivor of them or their heirs of such Survivor Do and Shall  
10 Soon as conveniently may be after my Decease Sell and dispose of  
11 the land for the best price that may or can be gotten for  
12 the And buy out of the Moneys arising by the Sale and  
13 Disposal thereof Do and shall in the first place Pay and Discharge  
14 all and every the just Debts that shall be owing from me to any  
15 person whatsoever at the time of my Decease And I Will and  
16 Direct that my said Wife shall have the Interest and Produce of the  
17 remainder of the Moneys arising by the Sale of my said Estate during  
18 her life and after her Decease do Give and Devise the said Moneys  
19 unto my Grandson Matthias Rogers Thorpe but Will and Direct  
20 that he shall not have the Disposal thereof till his age of One  
21 and Twenty years and I Will and Desire my said Wife to bring  
22 up and Educate my said Grandson till his age of One and Twenty  
23 years in the best manner she can And I Will and Direct that my  
24 said Wife Shall have the use of my household Goods Furniture  
25 and Plate during her life and after her Decease I give  
26 Give the same to my said Grandson Mattias Rogers Thorpe and I hereby  
27 Constitute and Appoint my said Wife and the said James  
28 Executor of this my last Will and Testament and revoke all former  
29 Wills and Declare this is my last Will and Testament In Witness  
30 Thereof I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand

31 And seal this Twenty Eighth Day of January in the year of our  
32 Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty two Edward Allin  
33 Signed Sealed Published and Declared by the above named Edward  
34 Allin the Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the  
35 Presence of us who have Subscribed our names as Witnesses thereto  
36 in the Presence of the said Testator and of each other. W. Harcourt
