**Will dated 1725**

### **R MUS Lyddington**

1 In the Name of God Amen I Prudence Browne  
2 of Liddington in the County of Rutland Widdow – do  
3 make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in  
4 man\ner following Impremis I give to my two Grandchildren  
5 Francis and *Elizabeth* Chantler 1 Guinea a piece and to my  
6 Sister Ireland 1 Guinea & my Desire and will is that my  
7 Grandson Francis Standish whom I make \my/ Sole  
8 Executor to give to my relations of my wearing Apparele  
9 what she thinks fit also I give to My Grandson  
10 Francis Standish whom I doe Make and Constitute  
11 my Sole Executor ale My Goods & Chatteles what  
12 Soever after my Funerale expense is defrayed which I  
13 desire may be very private I hereby Constitute my  
14 Grandson Francis Standish Sole Executor of this my  
15 last Will and hereby revoke ale former Wills in  
16 Wittness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and  
17 Seal the fourteenth day of March 1725-6  
18 Prudence Browne  
19 Signed sealed published and declared by  
20 the Testatrix to be her last will and  
21 Testament in the presence of us
