LAO Lydd wills 17

1 In the name of God Amen October the 13 day 1670
2 I Ann Clarke of Liddington in the County of
3 Rutland widdow beinge perfit in Memore and
4 Remembrece presed be All Mightye God and
5 I doe Make and Ordaine this my last will and
6 Testement in manner and forme as Followeth
7 first I Bequeath my Soule into the hands
8 of All Mightie God and my boydey to be
9 Berered in Christen like menner at the
10 discrisstion of my Execter
11 *Memerendem* I make my defter Ann Clarke
12 my Soule *Executer* and she is to performe
13 my Will
14 Item I give to my doffer Mary Sismey £5-0s-0d
15 Item I give to my doffer Elizabeth Fatherston £5-0s-0d
16 Item I give to All my Gran Childres
17 five shellings apeece
18 and she that keepeth my doffer
19 Elling is to have one cow
20 and All the Rest of my goods I give to
21 my doffer Ann Clarke to pay my leggeces
22 and to Bring mee to the ground and
23 shee is to have one yeere to pay the
24 leggeces wittness my hand
