1 In The Name of God Amen I James Hill of Liddington
2 in the County of Rutland yeoman being of perfect memory and
3 Remembrance Praised be God Do make and ordain This my last Will
4 and Testament in Manner and form following (*Videlicet*) First I bequeath
5 my Soul into the hands of Almighty god my Maker hoping that through
6 the meritorious death and Passion of Jesus Christ my only Saviour and
7 Redeemer to recieve full pardon and forgiveness of all my Sins And as
8 for my Body to be Buried in Christian Burial at the discretion of
9 my Executor hereafter nominated:
10 Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Browne the wife of
11 John Browne of Liddington in the County of Rutland Butcher The Sum
12 of Ten pounds of Lawfull mony of Great Britain at the End of one
13 year after my Decease if she so long live and allso all my household
14 goods:
15 Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Anne Curtis the wife of
16 Robert Curtis of Harringworth in the County of Northampton Yeoman
17 one Shilling of Lawfull mony of Great Britain
18 Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Partridge the wife of
19 William Partridge of Leicester the sum of one Shilling of Lawfull mony
20 of Great Britain
21 All the Rest of my Goods and Chattles and Freehold Lands whatsoever
22 I give and Bequeath unto my Son John Hill he paying my Legacies Debts
23 and Funeral Expences and Doe make him Sole Executor of this my last
24 Will and Testament In Wittness hereof I have sett to my hand and seal
25 the Nineteenth day of January Anno *que Domini* 1722
