1 Aprill the 2nd 1669
2 In the name of God Amen I Walter Nubon of Caldecoate
3 in the Countye of Rutland Carpenter Beinge in perfect
4 health and Memory blessed be God for the same I bequeathe my
5 Soule into the hands of Almightye \God/ my Creator & redeemer
6 And doe trust in the mercyes of Jesus Christ to be saved
7 And my bodye to be buried in the Church of Caldecoate. As
8 for these my earthlye goods which I nowe enjoye, I give
9 & bequeathe in Manner & forme As followeth:
10 Imprimis I give to Alice Nubon my wife all my goods & Cattell
11 after my decease duringe her naturall life And all my linnen
12 And peuter I give to her to be at her disposinge. Item I give
13 to my Brother Richard Goward twentye shillings Also I give to
14 Walter Goward his eldest sonn eight pounds. Also I give to
15 Richard Goward his second sonn twentye shillings. Alsoe I give to
16 Robert Goward his youngest sonn twentye shillings Alsoe I give to
17 Susanne Goward his eldest daughter twenty shillings Alsoe I give to
18 Tomisin Goward his youngest daughter twentye shillings. These Leag-
19 leagacies are to be payed by my executor one whole yeare after
20 the decease of mee & my Wife. Item I give to Edward Nubon my
21 Broother William sonn twentye shillings. Alsoe I give to Ann Nubon
22 my Broothers daughter twentye shillings Alsoe I give to my
23 Syster Skelhorne twentye shillings. Alsoe I give to Walter
24 Skelhorne twentye shillings Alsoe I give to Robert Skelhorne
25 twentye shillings These five leagacies are to be paid two years
26 after the decease of mee & my Wife. Item I give to Ann Nubon
27 daughter of John Nubon & Ann his Wife twentye shillings when
28 shee shall accomplish the age of one & twentye years. Item I
29 give to Ann Stokes daughter of Walter & Elizabeth twentye shillings
30 When shee shall accomplish the age of one & twentye years. Alsoe

31 I give to Richard Swansson & Thomas Swansson sones to Leonard
32 & Elizabeth his wife twentye shillings apeece when they shall
33 accomplish the age of one & twentye yeares. Alsoe I give unto
34 Suzannah Redshaw the some of five pounds Alsoe I give to Sarah
35 Redshaw the some of five pounds These two leagacies are to be paid
36 three years after the decease of mee & my Wife.
37 Item I give to Suzannah Redshaw one Cuberd one bedsted
38 one Coffe & one hillinge one blancket one paire of sheets and
39 one Mattrise one boulster & one pillow. Item I give to Widdow
40 Burnum & Bridget Burnum six pence apeece. I give to Joane
41 Slade six pence. I give to John Tomptson six pence to Leonard
42 Swansson six pence to Lawrence Nubon six pence to Alice Slye
43 six pence to Thomas Crofter six pence. Item I give to
44 Ann Redshaw my leace of demeanes All the rest of my goods
45 unbestoed & forgotten dets paide & funerall expences dis-
46 discharged I give and bequeath unto Ann Redshaw which I
47 make my full & sole executor of this my last will & testament
48 In witness hereof I have set to \my/ hand & seale the daye &
49 yeare within written
