- 14 Fyve Pounds of lawfull money of England To be distributed amongst them

- unto Robert Ward of Wardley in the County of Rutland aforesaid Twenty
- 17 Pounds of good and lawfull money of England And all the residue of my Goods
- 18 Cattells Chattells and personall Estate whatsoever My debts and Legacyes
- paid and funeral Expenses discharged I give and bequeath unto my well
- 20 beloved neece Elizabeth Middlemore now lyving with mee in Thorpe aforesaid
- 21 whome I doe hereby make constitute and appoint sole Executrix of this my
