**Will proved 1813**

### **ROLLR DE 73/83**

1 This is the last Will and Testament of me  
2 John Seaton of Lyddington in the County of Rutland  
3 Pigjobber First I give and bequeath unto my Daughter  
4 Elizabeth Seaton the Sum of Thirty pounds of lawful  
5 British Money Also I give and bequeath unto my Son  
6 William Seaton of Twenty pounds of like lawful  
7 Money which said Legacies and Sums I direct to be paid  
8 to my said Son and Daughter as soon as conveniently  
9 maybe after my Decease also I give and bequeath  
10 unto my Wife Hannah – All and Singular my  
11 Household Goods Furniture Plate Linen China and  
12 other Effects of a like sort or kind which shall  
13 be in and about my Dwellinghouse at the time of  
14 my Decease Except my Silver Tankard To hold the  
15 same for and during the Term of her natural life and  
16 from and after her Decease I give and bequeath the  
17 same and every part thereof unto my said Son William  
18 And my Daughters Elizabeth Susannah and Ann equally  
19 to be divided between them share and share alike  
20 Also I give and bequeath unto my Son John Seaton  
21 my Silver Tankard And also my farming Stock Cattle  
22 Crops and Implements in Husbandry And also all  
23 the rest and residue of my Monies Goods and Chattels  
24 Personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever  
25 And of what nature kind or sort soever the same  
26 maybe or consist at the time of my Decease  
27 to and for his own use benefit and disposal  
28 And I appoint my said Wife Hannah –  
29 Seaton and my said Son John Seaton as  
30 Executrix and Executor of this my last Will and Testament

31 In Witness whereof I the said John Seaton the Testator  
 32 have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and  
 33 Seal this Sixteenth Day of January one thousand eight  
 34 hundred and twelve
