Will proved 1725

1 I Kenelm Wright of Lidington in the County of Rutland Shepherd
2 Do this Fourteenth day of March in the Year of Our Lord One
3 Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty four make ordain and
4 Constitute this my Will and Testament in manner and Forme
5 following . First I give and Bequeath to each of my Children that
6 shall be alive at the time of my decease one Shilling a piece
7 Item all the rest and residue of my Goods Chattells mony moveables
8 and other my Personall Estate I Give and Bequeath to my Loving
9 wife (whom I make Sole Executrix of this my last will) for and
10 during the term of her naturall life if she shall so long keep herself
11 a widow and from and after her decease or Marriage with any other
12 person then I Give and Bequeath all my Goods Chattells mony
13 moveables and other my Personall Estate before Mentioned
14 to my Seven Children (viz) *William* Wright Thomas Wright John Wright
15 Ann Wright Elizabeth Wright Benjamin Wright and Richard
16 Wright to be Equally Divided between them share and share alike
17 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day
18 and Year above written
