made the Sixth day of February in the thre and thirtieth yeare of the Reigne of our most gracious
Soveraigne Lord Charles the sonne of our England, Scotland, France and Ireland King Defender of the faith & Between the
right houres of John Earle of Ester Baron of Burghley of the one parte, and Richard Cradding of Liddington in the County of
Rutland I husbandman of the other parte. **WITNESSETH** That the said Earle for and in consideration of the yearly rent receyved
provised and agred with him after record and contained on this parte and behalfe of the said Richard Cradding his Executors assignes
to be paid and performed. **WHICH** domisid leases and by those presents doth divide lease and to farme all
unto the said Richard Cradding. His Collage or countenant in Liddington aforesaid lately rebuilded with the profits and appurtenances
thereunto belonging now in the possession and occupancy of the said Richard Cradding or his assignes. **To have** and to hold the
said domisid premises with theire and boord of theirs appurtenances unto the said Richard Cradding his Executors Administrators
and assignes from the first day of St Michael the Arthangell last past before the date hereof unto the full end and term of one and
twentie yeares from the day next ensuing fully to be twelve moneths and ended. **RENT** And paying therfore yearly during
the said term the summe of eight shillings of landfull money of England at the feasts of the Annunciation of the blessed Virgin Mary
St Michael the Arthangell by equal partes. **ITEM** To the said Richard Cradding doth hereby for himselfe his Executors Administrators
and assignes to comynge and graunt to and with the said Earle his heires and assignes that the said Richard Cradding his Executors
Administrators and assignes shall and will from time to time during the said term at his and their owne proportiones and charges well and suffitiently
repaire upholt and maintaine and keepe the said domisid premises and boord thereof with all manner of woodfull and necessary repaire
and at the endes of the said term shall leade and yeile up the same unto the said Earle his heires and assignes well and suffitiently repaire
upholt and maintaine and keepe. **ITEM** Also shall and will discharge and pay all due and due taxes assyses and all maner of
paynes whatsoeuer which at any tyme or tyme during the said term shall be due and payable for or in respect of the premises or imposse
thereon for parshiall duties or by ded or or ordene ordinants or ordinantes act or acts of Parliament or otherwise howsoeuer as wch such taxes
rates as arre or shall be sette upon the said Earle as Landlord as upon the said Richard Cradding as Tenant of the domisid premises &
TERM shall and will from time to time during the said term upon warning or notice therof given do his and their parts and
forwite to the Courts Leet and Courts Baron of the said Earle his heires and assignes to be held within or for the Mennour of Liddington
aforsaid wher and as often as they or either of them shall haue cause to be kept and pay perforce obsoale and keepe all the orders
penalties and amerciaments wher shall be made aches or imposed upon him and them by the Stewards and Juries of the said
either of them for the tyme being. **RENT** always that if the yearly rent or any parte thereof shall be unpaid by the party
fourtene dayes next after either of the said feastes whereon the same ought to be paide aforesaid having good lawfully demandyd
if the said Richard Cradding his Executors Administrators and assignes shall at any tyme or tyme during the said term domisid deise or passe
the domisid premises or any parte thereof to any person or persons whatsoever other then to his or their wife or widow their or their
without licente for the same first had in writing under the handes and seals of the said Earle his heires and assignes that then and there
thenceforth this present domisid shall indeft notwithstanding and breake any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. **ITEM**
said Earle doth hereby for himselfe his heires and assignes to comynge and graunt to and with the said Richard Cradding his
Executors Administrators and assignes that he and they for and under the said term doth provised and agred with him in manner and
dolares shall or may from tyme to tyme during the said term peaceably and quietly haue shold and enjoy the aboue domisid premises
with their and boord of theirs appurtenances without the lett trouble or disturbance of the said Earle his heires or assignes or any other person or persons
whatsoever lawfully claiming by from or under him then or any of them In witness whereof the parties abovesaid to these presentes
intouchable hands and seals the day and yeaer first aboue written xxx.
