 of arable Land & meadow ground herein after named that is to
 saye vizt one land at Parrell Robert Ward west one land at Broadway
 wth Black well north one rood at white roody Walter ffreeman north one
 rood in north white roody wth on Bradshaw north one half acre layd at hoberjohn
 one land at fean furlong Thomas Caud west one rood more then wth on Bradshaw
 west one rood land over the waye Robert Ward East one land at water fully
 Walter ffreeman north one land at marsh Robert Smith East one land at short
 furlong Walter ffreeman west one sold in the meadow William Hill south
 one sold in the old meadow John Brown south with all singular therer ending
 therer appurtenances in Caldwell aforesaid & now in the bound & comparison of William
 Chapman to the use and behoofe of Lewis Woodcock and of his heirs assignes
 for ever according to the Customs of the said manor: ~~~~~

Provided always & upon this Condition notwithstanding that if I above named
 William Chapman by his or assignes or any of them shall not well &
 truly paye or cause to be paid unto I above named Lewis Woodcock by his
 or assignes or any of them the full & just summe of forty five pounds three
 shillings of good & lawfull money of Great Brittain at or upon the seventh day of
 maye which shall be in the year of our lord 1725 at one whole & entire
 payment without fraud or any delaye then this present quitrent shall be void
 or else to remain in full force strength & virtue //
