Whereas You have in Your custody a Surrender bearing date the fifteenth day of April
which was in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventeen made
from Moses Allen Gent a customary tenant of the Manner afores^t of all that his half
Year land lying dispersedly in the fields & meadows of Riddington afores^t with the
appurts within the Manner afores^t lately John Wrennes do the use & behoof of Robert
Smith of Waterley in the County of Northam Gent et his heirs assignes for ever
according to the custom of the said Manner conditioned for the payment of one hundred
pounds with legall interest for the same of lawfull money of Great Britain before
or upon the sixteenth day of April which should then be in the Year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & eighteen as by the said Surrender appears And whereas
the s^t sum of one hundred pounds with all interest for the same hath been paid unto me
the s^t Robert Smith in full discharge of the said Surrender

This is therefore to authorize & impower You the s^t John Blackwelle to deliver
up the s^t written Surrender unto the s^t Moses Allen to be caused to make
void & for You so doing there shall be your sufficient warrant witness
my hand this tenth day of April anno domini 1732.
