 my true & lawful Attorneys or Attorney for me & in my Name & on my behalf to Surrender  
 into the hands of the Lord of the Mannor of Liddington afores<sup>d</sup> cum membris in the s<sup>d</sup> County of  
 Rutland by the Tod according to the custom of the s<sup>d</sup> Mannor One Customary Messuage  
 or Tenem<sup>t</sup> with the Appurtes situate in Liddington afores<sup>d</sup> within the s<sup>d</sup> Mannor former  
 ly in the Tenure of John Cradding & lately of John Horsepole & which was formerly surrendered  
 To the use & behoof of me the s<sup>d</sup> William Richards my Heires & Assignes by one Simon  
 Fisher And all the Estate right Title Interest property Claim & demand whatsoever of me the  
 s<sup>d</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Richards of in & to the s<sup>d</sup> Premises To the Use & behoof of Beauchamp Fisher  
 of Liddington afores<sup>d</sup> Yeoman his Heires & Assignes or To the Use & behoof of William  
 Larratt of Liddington afores<sup>d</sup> Chandler his Heires or Assignes or To the Use & behoof  
 of such other Person or Persons his her or their Heires or Assignes as by the s<sup>d</sup> Beauchamp  
 Fisher shall be directed nominated or appointed And I doe hereby give & grant to my  
 s<sup>d</sup> Attorneys jointly or to either of them severally full power & authority To do perform &  
 execute all & every such lawfull act & acts thing & things as shall be requisite & necessary for  
 the Surrendering the s<sup>d</sup> p<sup>ts</sup> to the uses aforesaid according to the true intent & meaning hereof  
 in as full & ample manner as I my self could & might doe or perform the same in my own pro  
 -per person, hereby ratifying & confirming all & whatsoever my s<sup>d</sup> Attorneys or either of them  
 shall lawfully do in the p<sup>ts</sup> In Witness whereof I the said William Richards have  
 hereunto set my hand & seal this fourth day of April in the fifth Year of the Reign of  
 our Sovereign Lord King George the Second over Great Britain &c Annoque Dni 1732.
