

Christen Smith's Award
between Mr. Earl of Goring
Dant. Luffe & Geo. Sharmou.

4 Sept. 1747.

Whereas by agreement made the 11th day of October 1745 between Sir
Thomas Thurst, Thos Steward to the right Hon^{ble} the Earl of Exeter
Daniel Luffe and Edward Sherman about the repairs of their pound
Liddington Mills and the mill house belonging to the said Mills, it was
then agreed to refer the said repairs and what each of them should pay
towards the repairing of the said premises to the award and determination
of Rowland Smith of Barnardon the said premises have been since
repaired by the said Rowland Smith at the request of the said parties -
Now know ye that the said Rowland Smith having taken upon him the
charge of the said award and arbitr^{mt}. and having considered the
obligations of all the parties concerning the premises doth thereupon
putt into writing this his award arbitr^{mt}. and Judgm^t. in manner and
form following (that is to say) the said Rowland Smith doth award
arbitr^{mt}. and determine by these presents, That the said Earl of
Exeter shall pay towards the repairing of the above mentioned premises
the sum of Seventy three pounds five shillings and eight pence
(the whole charge exclusive of Timber) amounting to the sum of
One hundred and five pounds one shilling and four pence & pny
That the said Edward Sherman shall pay towards the above mentioned
repairs the sum of fifteen pounds five shillings and one penny unto
the said Earl of Exeter within one month next after the date hereof And
that the said Daniel Luffe shall pay towards the above mentioned repairs
the sum of Thirty pounds ten shillings and two pence unto the said
Earl of Exeter within one month next also after the date hereof if he
the said Daniel Luffe doth not forthwith assign over unto the said Edward
Sherman the Lease now subsisting between him and the said Earl of
Exeter of the above mentioned Mills house Lands &c for the remainder
of the said term therein to come and to be paid (at the costs and charges
of the said Edward Sherman) But if he the said Daniel Luffe shall assign
the said Lease as aforesaid unto the said Edward Sherman That then the
said Rowland Smith doth award the said Edward Sherman to pay the above
mentioned sum of Thirty pounds ten shillings and two pence awarded
to be paid by the said Daniel Luffe over and above the above mentioned
sum of fifteen pounds five shillings and one penny awarded to be
paid by the said Edward Sherman as above In Witness whereof I have
to this my award sett my hand the fourth day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven
