Gause in the Will of Mr. Wm. Hautourt dat 20: March 1707:

I have given & bequeath unto my son William Hautourt & to his heirs & assigns
all my freehold & copyhold messuages cottages & losses lands tenements and
hereditaments with the appurtenances lying & being in the town field liberties
of ^{in the parish of} Liddington & Blywater in the S. County of Rutland so hold the same unto
my s^r. son Wm. Hautourt his heirs & assigns forever Subject nevertheless and =
chargeable with one annuity or yearly Rent Charge by me given & devised =
unto my said wife in manner hereon after mentioned (that is to say) I give & =
devise unto my said wife one annuity or yearly Rent Charge of twenty eight
pounds & paid for & during the term of her natural life & her of all Taxes to be =
assessed and payable out of all my Real Estate in the said County of Rutland by me
given & bequeathed to my s^r. son Wm. Hautourt as afores^d. by two equal paym^{ts}.
in the year in the cleere porch of Liddington afores^d. at the feast of the =
Annunciation of the blessed Virgin Mary & St. Michael the arch angel the first
^{next} paym^{ts} to be made on such of the s^d. feasts as shall first happen of the
decease of my said Mother Hautourt and my mind & will is that in case the
s^d. annuity of twenty eight pounds & any part thereof shall be =
holind & unpaid by the space of ^{fourty} days next after any of the s^d. feasts
or days on which the same ought to be paid as afores^d. that then & so often it sh^{ll}
& may be lawful to & for my s^d. wife & her assigns into & upon all or any part
of my said Estate herewith charged as afores^d. to enter & distress for the same
and the s^d. distress to be distrained then & therefrom time to time to be forced to
take load & drive carry away & remove & keep untill the s^d.
yearly annuity of twenty eight pounds & all arrears thereof & all
costs & damages occasioned by non payment of the same shall be
fully satisfied & paid.
