 Rowlatt with the appurtenances within the Manor aforesaid
 To the Use and behoof of him the said Robert Dextor for and
 during the Term of his Natural Life and after his Decease
 To the Use and behoof of Mabella his wife for and during
 the Term of her Natural Life and after her Decease to the
 Use and behoof of the Right Heirs of him the said Robert
 Dextor for ever according to the Custom of the said Manor
