belonging in Caldresot aforesaid and then in Measure
and Comparison of ^{to the Use and}
Behoofe of John Cave the Elder decess of Caldresot
aforesaid Shepherd his Heires and Assignes
According to the Custom of the Said Manour
with Proviso there Underwritten to be holden
Payment of Sixty Pounds and ~~Three~~ Pounds
or Upon the Twelfth day of September
which should then be in the year of our Lord
1727 And whereas the Said Summe of Sixty
and Three Pounds with all Interest for the
same has been paid by Robert Shelhorn the younger
of Caldresot aforesaid husbandman son and heir of the
said Robert Shelhorn the Elder ^{to} Elizabeth
Cave widow and Coheir of the said John Cave decess
in full discharge and According to the true intent
and meaning of the said Proviso or Condition of
the said Surrender:

This is therefore to Authorize and empower
you to deliver up the said Surrender to the
said Robert Shelhorn the younger and for
your so doing this shall be by your sufficient
Warrant given under my hand this Twelfth
day of April Annoy Dni 1722:
