& now in the possession of the said John Cant his  
assignes or assignees by the said John Cant of the said  
said John Cant for the duration of the term of his natural  
life & from & after the death of the said John Cant  
of Elizabeth Cant daughter of the said John Cant  
& of her heirs assignes for ever according to the  
custom of the said Mand & of the will of the Lord

The said Lord shall do & do all of the will of the said
