Will dated 1674

LAO Lydd wills & inv 1

1 June the 29th 1674
2 In the name of god Amen I Thomas Fryer of Caldecot Laborer doe make
3 and ordayne this my last will and Testament in manner and forme
4 following, Item I give unto Clement Fryer of Weldon the sume of five
5 pound to bee payde within six monthes next after my decease; and I alsoe
6 give unto John Fryer of Hilton five pound to bee payd within six monthes
7 next after my decease, and all my wearing cloathes, and I likewise
8 give all the rest of my goods and chattels unbequethed unto John Thorpe
9 and Elizabeth Hill his daughter whom I make Executors of this my
10 last will and Testament. Witnes
11 Robert Laxton
12 And Mary Laxton
