1 **Memorandum That Edward Ward**

2 late of Caldecott in the County of Rutland Carpenter being of perfect mind and
3 memory and haveing an intention to dispose of his personall \and [*illegible*]/estate did severall
4 tymes before his death and alsoe upon the same day that he dyed being the Four-
5 teenth day of Aprill in the yeare of our Lord God One Thousand Six Hundred
6 Sixty Foure being alsoe then of perfect mind and memory speake and declare his
7 last will and Testament Nuncupative following (viz) I doe declare that Zachary Ward
8 my brothers sonne (meaning the sonne of Zachary Ward defuncte) shall be my
9 Sole Executor All which words or the like in Effect were spoken with a mind and
10 intent to Speake utter publish and declare his last will and Testament Nuncu-
11 pative in the presence of William Newbone and Robert Colwell *alias* Collin with
12 diverse other Credible Witnesses Witnes hereunto William Newbone Anne
13 Newbone her mark Robert Collins his marke Walter Newbone
